ON 11-25-2008 AT 1900 HRS K-9 DUDE WAS REQUESTED TO PERFORM A SEARCH OF A HOME AT 25145 TECLA IN THE CITY OF WARREN.THE NARCOTIC UNIT HAD EXECUTED A SEARCH WARRANT OF THE HOME. SEVERAL BUYS HAD BEEN MADE AT THE HOME AND IT WAS A CONSTANT COMPLAINT OF NEIGHBORS THAT THE HOME WAS DRUG HOUSE IN THEIR NEIGHBOR HOOD.

K-9 DUDE WAS TAKEN TO THE UPSTAIRS AND STARTED HIS SEARCH, HE WENT TO A COFFEE TABLE AND INDICATED TWICE ON CONTAINERS THAT WERE UNDER IT. BOTH CONTAINERS WERE FOUND TO HAVE MARIJUANA INSIDE ALONG WITH SCALES AND OTHER DRUG EQUIPMENT. DUDE CONTINUED HIS SEARCH IN THE 1ST FLOOR BEDROOMS.

HE ALERTED ON TWO SPOTS IN THE EAST SIDE BEDROOM AND BOTH CONTAINED MARIJUANA, THEN HE WENT TO THE WEST SIDE BEDROOM AND GAVE ANOTHER POSITIVE INDICATION OF NARCOTIC ODOR, THAT INDICATION REVEALED MORE MARIJUANA. DUDE'S SEARCH WAS DONE WITH THE HOMEOWNER'S TWO DOGS PRESENT, NUMEROUS NARCOTICS OFFICERS RUNNING AROUND AND MULTIPLE SUSPECTS IN THE HOME. ALL FIVE OF HIS INDICATIONS CONTAINED NARCOTIC,

A PHYSICAL SEARCH OF THE HOME BY OFFICERS DID NOT LOCATE ANY MORE NARCOTICS. IT IS FOR DUDE'S EXCELLENT NARCOTIC WORK WHICH HELPED OFFICERS ERADICATE A DRUG HOUSE IN OUR NEIBORHOODS AND PLACE SEVERAL SUBJECTS IN JAIL, THAT I REQUEST THE USPCA TO CONSIDER HIM FOR A K-9 AWARD.
