THE SEARCH WARRANT WAS OBTAINED AND K-9 DUDE WAS BROUGHT IN TO PERFORM A NARCOTIC SEARCH. K-9 DUDE LOCATED MARIJUANA IN THE BEDROOM, IN BETWEEN COUCH CUSHIONS, AND UNDER THE COUCH. ALONG WITH THE MARIJUANA UNDER THE COUCH 2 PLASTIC BAGS CONTAINING MONEY WAS ALSO LOCATED. A FURTHER SEARCH OF THE HOME BY OFFICERS TURNED UP A LOADED HANDGUN INSIDE THE REFRIGERATOR. DUE TO GOOD POLICE WORK OF THE RESPONDING OFFICERS, AND THE WORK OF K-9 DUDE, WARREN POLICE WERE ABLE TO FORFEIT A TOTAL OF \$50,459.00 DOLLARS, REMOVE A GUN FROM THE POSSESSION OF A DRUG DEALER, RECOVER MARIJUANA, AND OBTAIN AN ARREST WARRANT FOR THE MALE SUSPECT OF THE APARTMENT
